"Recordings" is a forthcoming Snapper release compiling new studio material together with Bsides taken from the UK only singles. Expect this around April.

"Stars Die - The Delerium Years - 1991 - 1997" is a double CD set due for release around the same time, and as the title suggests is a comprehensive overview of the early stages of Porcupine Tree's career on Delerium. It features a hefty booklet detailing the complete history of the band including excerpts from interviews with all four members. Early plans for a triple vinyl issue unfortunately had to be dropped due to financial constraints.
