Delerium Records still hold the rights on all PT's albums to date, and will continue to be available through the usual channels. However, the first three albums, *On The Sunday Of Life, Up The Downstair* and *The Sky Moves Sideways* will be slowly deleted over time to make way for a 'best of' album sometime nearer the millennium.

RECENT RELEASES

Metanoia, a collection of out-takes from the Signify sessions was recently released as a limited edition of 1,000 on two 10" singles in a colour gatefold sleeve (Chromatic 003). Record one contains tracks entitled 'Mesmer 1', 'Mesmer 2', 'Mesmer 3' and 'Coma Divine' recorded in Cambridge on 13 July 1996 and features Steve, Colin, Chris and Richard. Record two contains tracks entitled 'Metanoia 1', 'Intermediate Jesus' and 'Metanoia 2' recorded at the Doghouse studios in Henley-on-Thames on 4th March 1996 featuring Colin, Chris and Steve. The bonus mystery track is 'Milan' recorded, not surpassingly, in Milan on the same tour that brought us the Coma Divine album. A special prize is offered to the person who sends us their best explanation of what they think is going on.

IEM's eponymous sub-Kraut-rock meisterwerk is finally released on CD with an extra track. This off-shoot project for Steve is out now on Delerium Records (DELEC CD 047). Tracks are: 'The Gospel According To The IEM', 'The Last Will And Testament Of Emma Peel', 'Fie Kesh', 'Deafman', 'Headphone Dust'. Don't forget to duck when you hear the 747 approaching.
